In light of recent news regarding formaldehyde emissions in laminate flooring we have received several inquiries this week regarding CARB compliance related to our product lines. We want to provide you with reassurance about our ongoing commitment to compliance for Pinnacle flooring products.

Pinnacle has long held a position of environmental responsibility with regard to the products we bring to market. Quality and product safety have been a benchmark for us since our company was founded in 1999, as well as compliance with local, state, federal and international law. With the inclusion of solid and engineered products in the Lacey Act, and the implementation of CARB I and II, we have required that our products comply with these guidelines. Environmental requirements, including those regarding formaldehyde emissions, such as the California Air Resources Board (CARB), are part of that requirement and commitment to our customers.

Our specifications require that products manufactured on behalf of Pinnacle Interior Elements are certified to meet CARB requirements. Our factories submit their products to independent, certified labs for testing and certification. In addition, we test our products stateside to confirm the testing done overseas.
